

Environmental Information for Electricity Supplied by Public Power, LLC



The following environmental information is for electricity supplied by Public Power, LLC ("Public Power").

Power plants can generate electricity from a number of different fuel sources, resulting in different Emissions. Public Power will report fuel sources and emissions data to customers twice annually, allowing customers to compare data among the companies providing electricity service in the District of Columbia.

Public Power may have used the following energy sources to supply electricity in the District of Columbia from January 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022.
